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DETAILS OF THE LABORATORIES, ANIMAL HOUSE & HERBAL GARDEN

MNR Dental College and Hospital has contemporary laboratories where students can observe, learn and practice various simulation activities. Students can apply the theoretical concepts in the laboratories and learn aspects step by step.

PRECLINICAL FACILITIES include:

1. The phantom head lab in conservative dentistry trains the second year students on cavity preparation and restoration on dummy models before the clinical work on patients.
2. The Preclinical lab of Prosthodontics trains the first and second year students on making RPD and CD before they do it on patients.
3. Pre clinical Phantom lab of Prosthodontics trains final year students on crown preparation.
4. Department of Oral & Maxillo-facial surgery trains the clinical students on suturing and wiring on dummy models.
5. Department of Periodontia trains the students on dummy models to get a feel of grips and rests before doing scaling on patients.
6. Department of Pedodontia trains students for space maintainers and regainers on dummy models.
7. Department of Orthodontia prepares the students for clinical work by pre clinical exercises of wire bending and making appliances.
8. Basic Life Support courses are conducted for the third year students and certified by professional organizations and they work on mannequins in Medical College for reinforcing their knowledge.

9. Practical Laboratories are available in all basic medical science departments to create a platform for understanding the basic concepts of subjects like Anatomy, Physiology, Biochemistry, Pharmacology, Pathology and Microbiology.

PRECLINICAL LAB

There are 4 preclinical laboratories which are well equipped for teaching, demonstration and for doing the procedures.

1. Preclinical Prosthodontic laboratory has more than 150 work spots which handles the first and second year students.
2. The Preclinical conservative laboratory has mannequins to develop skills for performing conservative dental procedures.
3. Phantom head lab of Prosthodontics helps students in preclinical work of crown preparation. There are many phantom head units for the same.
4. The preclinical Lab of Oral Histology & anatomy and Oral Pathology has many microscopes for visualising histology sections and also has provision for tooth carving.

CLINICAL LAB

There are 6 fully equipped clinical labs for the smooth functioning of the college.

1. The clinical lab of haematology serves the patients for their routine blood tests.
2. The Oral Pathology lab has a state of the art research Microscope, and Automatic Microtome is there in Oral pathology. These along with other accessories help the staff produce good biopsy results.
3. There are clinical laboratories in the Departments of
 - Prosthodontics,
 - Conservative Dentistry,
 - Orthodontics and
 - Paedodontics for the students to complete their patient work.

ANIMAL HOUSE:

The animal house in MNR Dental College aids in training and research activities. The facility is a CPCSEA-approved facility with animals maintained hygienic and under controlled environmental conditions. The students are exposed to the various animals like swiss albino mice, balb/c mice, rats and rabbits that used for research in relation to dentistry in the animal house.

HERBAL GARDEN:

The students are exposed to various medicinal plants at the herbal garden for various research activities in MNR Dental College. Undergraduate students learn the benefits and uses of various species of plants grown in the garden. The students were enriched with a hands on experience about the medicinal value of plants including growing and extracting the medicinal ingredients from these medicinal plants.

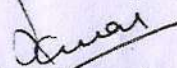

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DETAILED REPORT OF ACTIVITIES OF LABORATORY RESOURCES

Our institute has laboratories where students can observe, learn, and practice various simulation and mock activities. This exposure to hands-on- practical training helps develop their practical competence in various fields of dentistry and allied sciences.

FIRST YEAR BDS:

Sl.No	NAME OF LABORATORY	ACTIVITIES
1.	PHYSIOLOGY LAB	- Undergraduates' students utilize the sphygmomanometer apparatus for measuring the blood pressure. - The students also use the hemoglobinometer for estimation of haemoglobin levels in blood and compound microscope for analysis of peripheral smear and total count.
2	BIOCHEMISTRY LAB	Analysis of serum and urine glucose, albumin, ketone bodies, bile salts and pigments are done using test tubes and pipettes.
3	HUMAN ANATOMY AND EMBROLOGY LAB	- Section of fixed normal human tissues is studied using compound microscope. - Anatomy laboratory provides cadaver for dissections. - Human organs and specimens are kept for identification and detailed studying.

4	PRECLINICAL CONSERVATIVE DENTISTRY & ENDODONTICS LAB	- Students are trained to perform cavity preparations on plaster models and on extracted teeth. - Students are trained for cavity designs, and restoration for silver amalgams and cast restoration. - The students learn to identify dental material and study materials in detail, demonstration of manipulation, dental cements and silver amalgam is given. - The exercises are planned so that the students are trained for material manipulation. - Preclinical phantom lab has head tables with mannequins in Conservative dentistry departments to enable the undergraduate students to have skilled preclinical learning.

1.	ORTHODONTICS LAB	Students are trained for various wire bending exercises and demonstrative for fabrication of orthodontic appliances.
2	ORAL PATHOLOGY AND MICROBIOLOGY LAB	The department of oral and maxillofacial pathology supports nine clinical specialties of dentistry by providing clinical and histopathological diagnosis. A fully equipped histopathology lab, haematology lab and immunohistochemistry lab cater to patients, care and research purposes. Undergraduates undergo discussion of primary and permanent dentition casts and models, microscopic examination and ground sectioning.

SUMMARY:

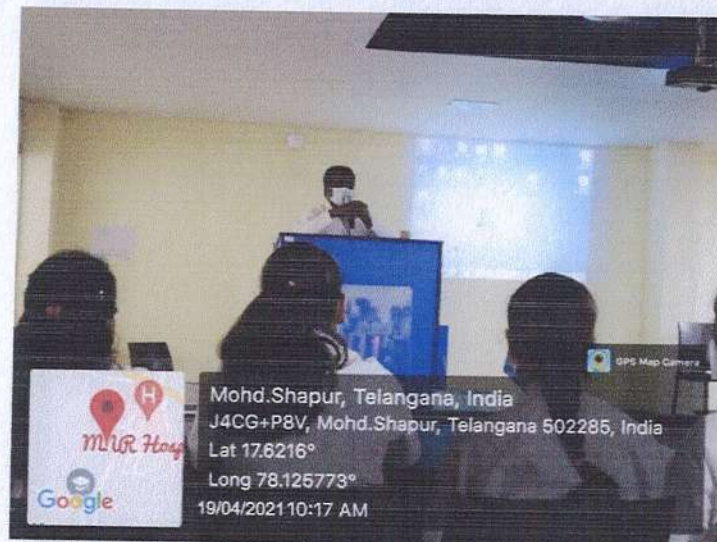

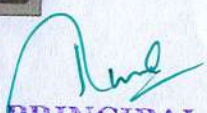
Conclusion: The program gave an understanding of animal ethics and students gained an insight on the application of animal models in dentistry.

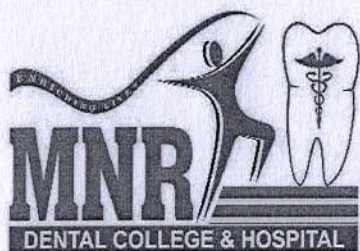
