ACTIVITY REPORT - 7th NOVEMBER - 2024

Event Title: "Seeing the Unseen" - An Exhibition Celebrating World Radiology Day 2024

Date: 7th November 2024

Time: 1:00 PM onwards

Introduction: In celebration of World Radiology Day, every year celebrated on November 8th, the Department of Oral Medicine and Radiology at MNR Dental College hosted an exhibition titled "Seeing the Unseen," aimed at encouraging students to creatively explore and represent various jaw and skull pathologies.

The students did a beautiful Orthopantomography radiograph Rangoli with white and black color and labeled the title of 20204 theme. This initiative allowed students to artistically express complex pathological concepts through unique visual representations, their by highlighting radiology's crucial role in diagnosing complex conditions.

Event Highlights: The exhibition showcased an impressive array of art and craft pieces focused on jaw and skull pathologies, executed solely in black and white, in adherence to the theme's guidelines. Each team of four students created their own visually compelling and scientifically accurate pieces, which were presented by two active team members on the exhibition day.

On that day we had chief guest Smt. K. Lalitha Kumari, Deputy Director of Women and Children Welfare Department, Telangana state. Currently working as district welfare officer, Sangareddy district. Madam was very happy to see students exhibiting their knowledge in art form and explaining her about the pathological diseases. She congratulated all the participants and wished them for the upcoming university exam.

Event Proceedings: The event began at 1:00 PM with an introduction by Dr. Bhuvaneshwari, Professor in the Department of Oral Medicine and Radiology, who set the stage for the day's activities. Following this, final year student Varshitha delivered the welcome speech. Dr. Ravindra SV, Principal, professor & HOD of the Department, addressed the gathering, sharing insights into the significance of World Radiology Day and emphasizing radiology's applications in diagnosing and treating medical and dental diseases.

Exhibition Setup and Judging: Students were assigned various stations to present their artwork, a total of 17 work stations were setup. Each table focusing on specific radiographic topics such as periosteal reactions, cyst and tumors pathologies. Utilizing only black and white, the participants demonstrated their understanding of radiographic nuances through intricate art forms that depicted different pathologies.

The event was judged by Dr. Ravindra (Professor and HOD of OMR Department) and Dr. Ramesh, (HOD of the Oral Surgery Department). Scoring was based on the creativity and accuracy of the students' presentations. The exhibition also saw active participation from other department heads and faculty members, who engaged students with questions, providing encouragement and feedback.

Awards: The prize winners were announced at the end of the event, recognizing the most outstanding presentations.
